MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND EVALUATION FESTIVAL PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE Friday, March 8th @ Muskegon High School

Students need to arrive to **school wearing their full band uniform.** The uniform consists of ALL black pants, black socks, all black shoes and green band polo.

SCHEDULE

- 7:40 Students check in with 1st hour teacher and listen to announcements.
- 7:40 7th Grade Band reports to the band room | 8th Grade Band reports to the choir room
- 7:50 Begin loading large instruments into the trailer
- 8:00 Load Busses
- 8:10 Leave CMS
- 8:55 Arrive at Muskegon High School
- 9:20 7th Grade Band goes to Warm Up
- **9:50 7th Grade Band Performs** (8th Grade Band watches)
- 10:10 7th Grade Band Sight Reads
- 10:45 8th grade assembles instruments and goes into warm up
- **11:20 8th Grade Band Performs** (7th grade band watches)
- 11:40 8th Grade Band Sight Reads
- 12:00 Both bands eat lunch together
- 12:45 Load trailer and busses
- 1:00 Leave Muskegon for CMS
- 1:45 Arrive back at CMS and unload instruments

If anytime remains at the end of the school day, students will remain in the band room working on homework until the bell rings.

WHAT TO BRING

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Students without a full uniform will be unable to go with the bands to festival and will be sent back to class, they will also receive a "0" for this major performance.
- We encourage all family members to attend this FREE public performance. Parents may also follow the bands into the sight reading room and watch!
 - No photos or video is permitted during sight reading.
- Students may not play any instrument until in the official warm up room.
 - Failure to follow these rules could result in the bands being disqualified.
- A professional recording will be available to purchase following the performance.
- Students are responsible to turn in any homework due on Friday as well as make up any missing work.
